Millennium Monte

9 – 14 January 2000

NHMC were represented on the recent 'Monte Carlo Challenge' organised by the Classic Rally Association.

Alan Gilbert, as navigator, teamed up with Chris Tucker (from Lockington) and Peter Kendrick (from Edinburgh) to undertake this recreation of the original Monte Carlo Rally in Chris's 1952 Mark 6 Bentley. There were two routes, the sporting route and the Marathon route. The team chose the latter as it was more suitable to novices and gave a bed every night!



The event had several starting points, as of old, and the team were allocated a start in Ypres (Belgium). Scrutineering took place on Saturday 8 January in the centre of Ypres and was organised by the local motor club, AC Targa Florio, who also organised an evening meal for all and a memorable visit to the Menen Gate (where the names of over 60000 soldiers without known graves are inscribed) for the playing of the 'Last Post'. A daily event which takes place at 8pm!

At 10am, on Sunday 9 January 2000, the Mayor of Ypres 'flagged off' the 33 teams to begin their concentration run south. After an overnight stop in Gerardmer the route took them to Poligny where they joined fellow competitors who had started at other locations. Mid morning Monday saw the start of 4 eventful days of competitive motoring.

During Monday the Bentley developed a clattering noise from the transmission when under power. This was investigated at the overnight halt in Aix-les-Bains where the rear axle U-bolts were found to be loose. The bolts were tightened and all seemed OK again - at that point the team were 17th overall and 1st in class.

Last minute checks on Tuesday morning suggested all was well, then as Chris slammed the drivers door his mirror fell off and smashed! Then, as proof to superstition, the car refused to start! It was soon established that the twin electric fuel pumps were not working but a hefty thump with a metal bar brought them to life.

Joy was short lived, however, because after about 9 Km along the R201 road both SU pumps failed. Repairs on the cold and wet motorway took nearly 3 hours but a cut, missing out two time controls plus a regularity section, got the team to the fourth time control of the day 14 minutes late. Luckily the next section was cancelled due to impassable roads so the next control saw the team back on time. The following regularity section was also subsequently cancelled, due to a faulty marshals clock, so, after an eventful day the team arrived in Valence 55th overall and 6th in class.

Wednesday was a civilised 8-hour day starting, for the team, at 10.47. This was a fairly non-eventful day but the size of the car made it impossible to keep on time and 19 minutes was lost at time controls plus another 7 minutes 53 seconds on two regularity sections (Col Boutiere and Col de Pommerol). The day ended at Gap with the team 51st overall and 5th in class.

Thursday saw a 05.17 start for the team when the temperature was minus 10 degrees centigrade!! The initial sections took them along the Col de Maure (alt 1346m) and the Col du Labouret (alt 1240m) and both were very narrow with ice! 13 Minutes were lost due, mainly, to the size of the car and the weather conditions. A glance at the maps showed the first regularity of the day was along the Col de Corobin which appeared worse than roads already encountered that day at an altitude of 1230m - a decision was made to cut the regularity to get back on time. That proved to be a good decision because on a section around the ski resort of Valberg another 18 minutes was lost which, without the cut, would have put the team OTL.

The last regularity was along the famous rally road, the Col de Turini which, for most competitors, was more of a hill climb than a regularity with a required average speed of 45.5 kph. The team lost a further 2 minutes 44 seconds on that regularity which effectively brought to an end the competitive part of the event. After a break at the Hotel les Trois-Vallees, which is at the top of the Col, all that remained was a timed drive into the finish at Cannes where a brilliant reception had been organised by the Cannes Motor Club. On arrival in Cannes the temperature was 21 degrees centigrade - 31 degrees higher than the early morning temperature!



Final results were announced on Friday morning and Chris, Alan and Peter found themselves 48th overall and 5th in class with total penalties of 2 hours 49 minutes and 4 seconds. Bearing mind there had been 110 starters with 70 classified finishers the team are well please with their performance!
