Melbourne Airfield is situated on the unclassified road at MR. 105 / 763 428

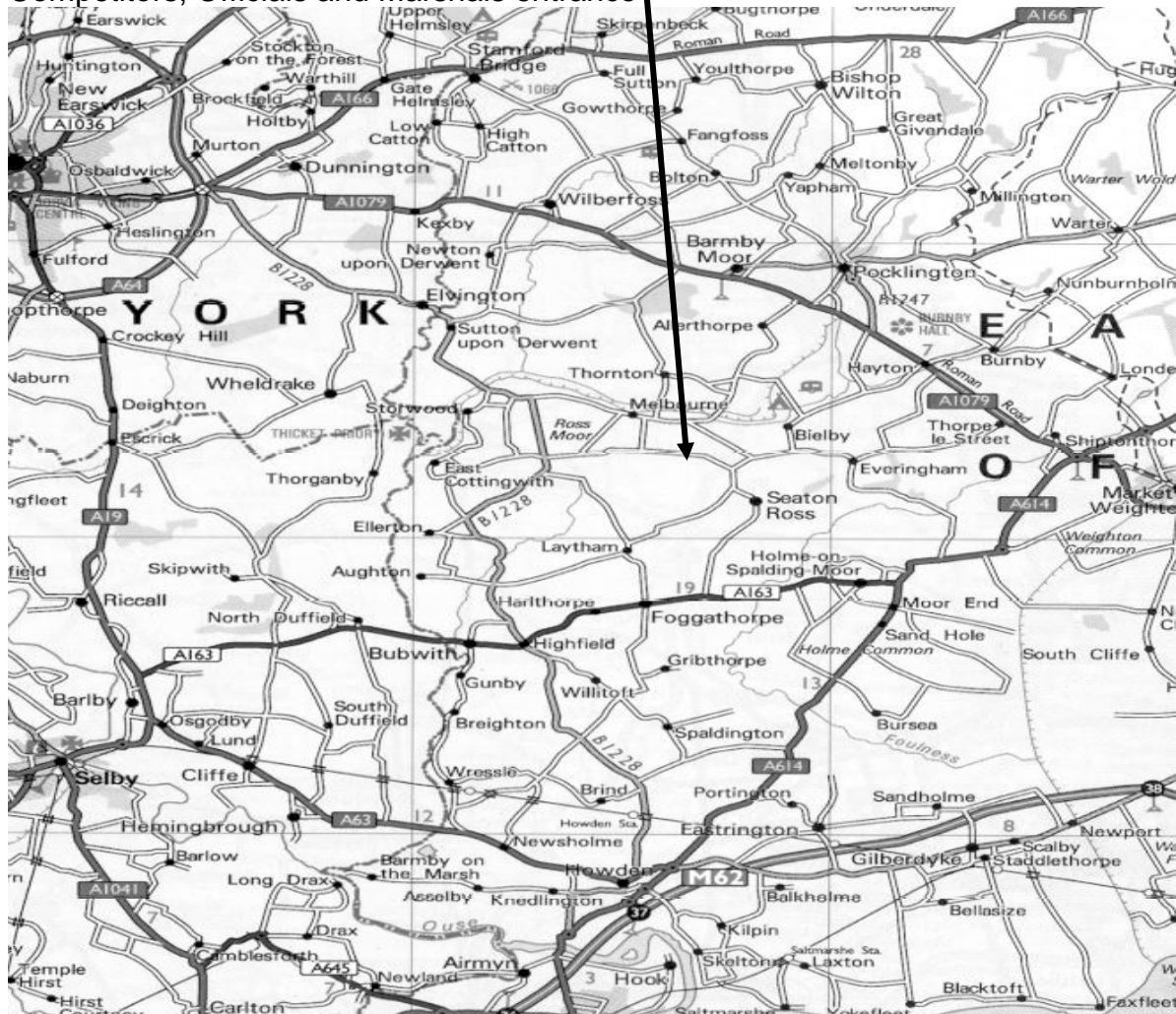
Enter the venue from:

**Entry to the venue**

Only enter the venue as described on page one, all other entrances to the venue are strictly private and may warrant the cancellation of the event if they are used. The correct entrance may be arrowed off the public highway. Once on the venue follow the directions on the enclosed diagram to the service area. A speed limit of 15 mph is in force.

Entry is between 12 noon and 21.30hrs on Saturday and 06.00 and 08.00 hrs on Sunday, no access will be available before or after these times. You can come and go from the venue as you please on Saturday within the above times specified and using the route shown on the diagram.

**Noise Test & Scrutineering**

Noise Test and Scrutiny will take place on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> May between 3pm at 7pm in the service area on the venue. Please present your car at Noise Check upon arrival. Noise check will be sign posted in the service area; (and as marked on the enclosed diagram) you will be issued with a scrutineering and documentation card at Noise Test. There is NO provision for scrutiny on Sunday morning. If you are delayed or broken down on route to the event please ring the Secretary of the Meeting, Robert Newlove on 07764 140205. or the entries secretary Alan Gilbert 07917 845930

**Door Numbers etc.**

Numbers and other such items can be purchased from **CJ. Rallying** who will be attending on Saturday only during the scrutineering times. Extra numbers required for the Practice Rally will be available from the organisers. (until we run out)

**Fuel**

There is no fuel available on the venue and you are advised to bring enough to last for the full day. The total stage mileage is approximately 55 miles.

**Stage Surfaces.** (Percentages are approximate)

Melbourne is a disused airfield. The tracks consist of the following:

- 70% sealed concrete and tarmac.
- 30% as above but cracked, broken, loose and crumbling surfaces.
- The grass track mentioned in the regulations will **NOT** be used on this year's event.

**Catering**

A catering van will be on site throughout the event situated in the service area.

**Toilet Facilities**

Toilets including disabled facilities are available on the venue throughout the event. Please look after them.

**Drinking Water**

There is a standpipe located behind the toilet block, which has a supply of water drawn from a borehole. The Landowner and North Humberside Motor Club Ltd cannot guarantee the safety of this supply and we strongly recommend that you **do not** use this supply for human consumption. The safest option is to bring your own.

**The stage start procedure.**

The start will be signalled by automatic traffic lights. There will be NO verbal countdown.

A comprehensive list of instructions for the stage start procedure can be found in your competitors pack and on the official notice board.

**Time Cards**

You will be issued with **Time Card 1** at documentation; your due time at MTC1 will have been entered on that card by the organisers and also posted on the Official Notice Board. Once you have completed stage 1, hand the timecard in at the Card Collection Control situated just past the stop line, you will be issued with your next timecard here, it will show your due time at the ATC for the next stage.

**Camping, Caravans & Motor Homes**

There is a limited amount of space within the service area for caravans & motor homes and there is grass alongside the service area for the pitching of tents and parking trailers. Please park with consideration for others.

**Children & Pets**

Children & pets are welcome on the venue as long as they are supervised by a responsible adult at all times. Dogs and other such animals must be secured by a lead at all times, preferably in a crate during the competition.

**NO OPEN FIRES** and **NO FIREWORKS**. Failure to comply with these simple rules will result in a cancelled event and the loss of another venue.

**Awards Presentation**

This will take place on the airfield as soon as possible after the last stage has been completed. The awards will be presented in front of the York Raceway Control Tower. (Near the Stop Line of the last stage).

**Early Departure from the venue.**

Competitors who wish to leave the venue before the end of the last stage may only do so after stages 2, 4, & 6 have been completed. Please be ready to leave in a convoy near the high level Fire Point sign in the service area. An official car may escort you from the venue after each batch of 2 stages has been completed.
