# CCW's Steve Berry reveals plans for Yorkshire classic spectacular

Television presenter Steve Berry is planning a 'Goodwood of the North' at a Yorkshire race circuit after being inspired during a CCW visit there.

Berry, who writes our regular *Berry On Classics* column, is preparing to launch a new show at the Oliver's Mount circuit, near Scarborough, and held a preview day on 20 September to gauge interest from classic owners.

He said: "I was extremely pleased with the way the event has been received, because the intention was to make people fall in love with Oliver's Mount like I did.

"The only real way to do this is to let them drive on closed roads, so that's what we're doing; you get a good idea

from driving Britain's last street circuit within the speed limit on a normal day, but to know you can take the straight flat out and hammer into that hairpin - that's special."

Steve had the idea for the event, titled the East Coast Classic, after he took his Citroën XM out for several laps of the circuit during CCW's spring tour of North Yorkshire in April.

Dates for the 2014 event have yet to be confirmed, but Steve hinted that it may be possible to buy joint tickets for both the East Coast Classic and the Manchester Classic Car Show.

The circuit, so-named because Oliver Cromwell may have sited cannons there during the English Civil War, has hosted car and bike races since the 1940s.

## Entries open for the SA GAS Premier Rally and Premier Historic Rally

Entries are now available for the 2013 Premier Rally & Premier Historic Rally supported by S.A. Gas Engineering. The event will run in a very compact format on Sunday 24th November to make a more attractive and affordable event for competitors. It will be held entirely within Sherwood Pines forest with 6 stages totalling 33 forest stage miles and ZERO road miles and service time after nearly every stage. This format means that rally cars do not have to be taxed or insured for the public highway.

To achieve such a compact format the **maximum entry is limited to just 65 cars**. In the last 2 years ear there was a full entry + reserves so we encourage competitors to enter the event as soon as possible. The event is a qualifying round of the 2013 Dansport EMAMC Stage Rally Championship, the Roadrunner/ Phoenix Awards ANEMMC Stage Championship and the AEMC Ward Trophy plus the final round of the popular Dukeries Motor Club Rally Championship. Scrutineering and Documentation will be available on Saturday afternoon from 1.30pm to 4.30pm at a location adjacent to the venue and on Sunday morning from 7.30am in Sherwood Pines. There will be a Stage Practice event option for those competitors who are unfortunate enough to retire on the early stages.

We encourage competitors to submit their entry using the simple on-line entry system with payment by bank transfer, PayPal or cheque. The event guarantees a full refund if an entry has to be withdrawn before the closing date.
